FACILITIES DEFINE THE OPPORTUNITY

Participating facilities list accepted materials and choose a per-drop driver recovery incentive - from \$0 to any amount they determine.

DRIVERS FIND VERIFIED DESTINATIONS

Drivers see participating facilities, accepted materials and available incentives so they can make informed routing decisions.

VERIFIED DROPS CLOSE THE LOOP

CreteXchange verifies completed drops. The facility pays CreteXchange \$5 for each verified drop through the platform.

LAUNCH PARTICIPATION MODEL

No subscription or enrollment fee for drivers or facility owners. Facilities control the recovery incentive they offer. CreteXchange charges the facility only when a drop is verified through the platform.
